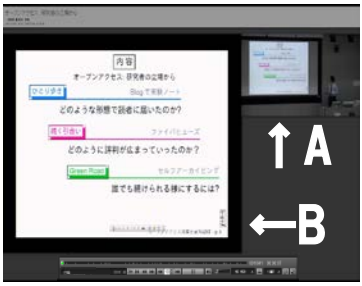


Permission for Storage and Use of Audiovisual Materials
