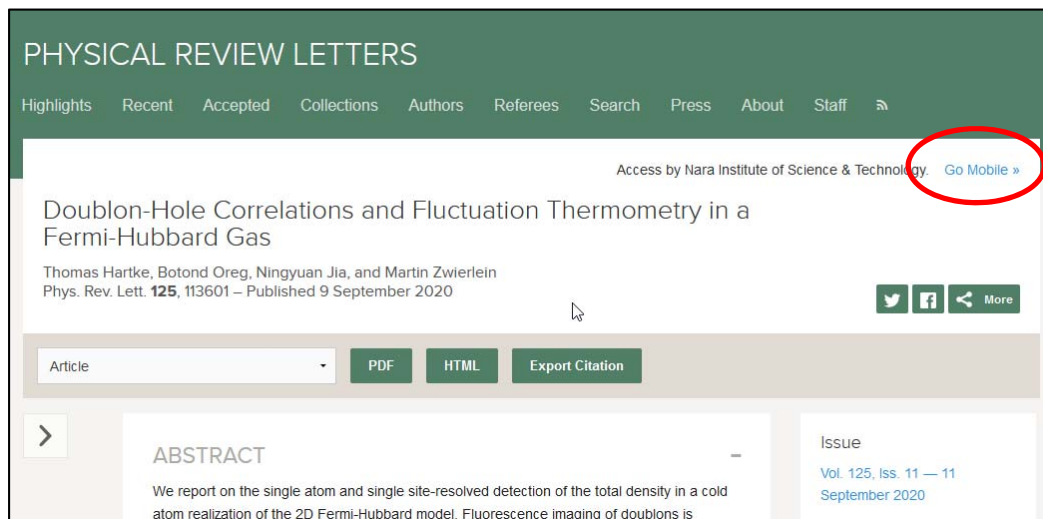
APS のアカウントを作成することで、学外でも大学が購読するコンテンツにアクセスできるようになります。

初回登録は大学内のネットワークから、リモートアクセスに使用する端末を使って行ってください。

You can use your APS Journal account to make your institutional subscriptions accessible from any of your computers or devices.

For the first time, you need to access from NAIST on-campus network with your device.

1. APS Journal Account を作成する (すでにアカウントを持っている方は2へ)
Create APS Journal Account. (If you had already created, go 2)

2. リモートアクセスで使用する端末を使って、NAIST の学内ネットワークから Journal のページにアクセスする。
どれか1論文(任意)にアクセスし、Abstract ページを開く。画面右上にある Go Mobile >> のリンクをクリックする。
Access to any abstract page from NAIST on-campus network with your device which you want to use remote access from now on.
Click on the "Go Mobile >>" link. It is located in the upper right-hand corner of the abstract page



3. Mobile Subscription Sign Up の表示が出たら、Activate を押す。
3 か月間学外からでもアクセス可能になる。
Click the 'Activate' button. This will give you subscription access whenever you are logged in with your APS Journal account, wherever you may be, from any device you may be using. You will be able to get remote access for up to three months.

Mobile Subscription Sign Up

You can access APS journals from home, on your mobile devices, or while on the road using your APS Journal Account. Clicking "Activate" below will associate your institution's subscriptions with your account for a period of two weeks. This period may be extended by visiting the Mobile Subscription tab of your "My Account" page while at your institution.
